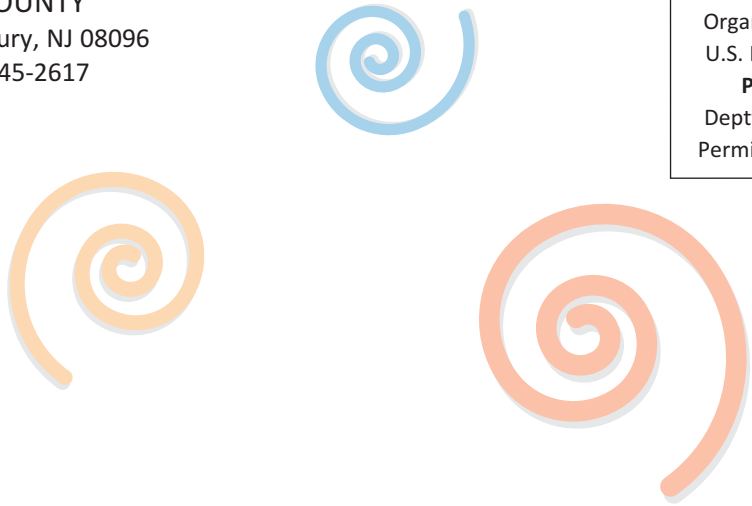

Leadership

Tish Davis, our School Aged Child Care Director, will be the New Summer Day Camp Administrator!

Lunches

Lunches are prepared by outside vendors and brought in each day to the YMCA. Lunches are not included in the price of camp. The lunches are \$4.00 per day.

Multi-Child Family Discount

Family is considered those living in the same household. There is a \$20.00 discount per cycle for the second child. Families with more than three children will be handled on an individual basis. To receive this discount, family members must be signed up for the same cycle. CIT program not included in Multi-Child discount.

Late Fee/Refund/Switching Fee Policies

The \$55 yearly membership fee and deposits for each cycle are non-refundable. A credit or refund may be given if the refund request/switching form is completed two weeks prior to each cycle (less the registration fee and deposits). There is a \$20 processing fee for switching. All balances must be paid two weeks prior to each cycle start date. There is a \$30 late fee for all late payments. There is a \$10 cancellation fee for extended day care.

FAQ...

Where is Camp Glo-Co?

The camp is located in Woodbury on East Red Bank Avenue, two blocks from Underwood Memorial Hospital and 1/2 mile from Deptford Skating Rink.

Who are the counselors and staff?

They are excellent role models from all over the county. Counselors are carefully screened, interviewed twice and selected on the basis of skill, enthusiasm, warmth, and a sincere love and desire to work with kids. We have a 85% retention rate of summer staff counselors.

What is the ratio of staff to camper?

There are 7-8 campers to one staff member.

Are waterfront activities supervised?

Definitely! Whether it is at our pool or at an off-camp pool or lake we have certified YMCA instructors and lifeguards. Swim lessons are taught by our YMCA instructors and are included in the cost of Summer Camp.

LOCATION & HOURS...

The YMCA Camp Glo-Co is located at the YMCA of Gloucester County in Woodbury. Camp begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m.

Extended Day - Woodbury: We offer "before camp" 7:00 - 9:00 a.m. and "after camp" 4:00 - 6:00 p.m.

PARENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

1. The above child has been given a routine medical examination and has been found to be free of infections or contagious diseases and is up to date with all immunizations.
2. Any conditions which might affect this child's performance at camp or any conditions of which the staff should be aware (medical treatment, special requirements as to diets, allergies, avoidance of certain activities, and other care) are listed above.
3. I hereby give authorization to secure emergency medical treatment in the event of illness or injury. I understand prudent attempts will be made to contact the undersigned immediately.
4. All subsequent changes require a \$20 switching fee.
5. In signing this agreement for my child, I certify that s/he is able to participate fully in the program unless otherwise stated in writing to the YMCA of Gloucester County. In the case of my child being removed from camp, I understand that there will be no refund of camp fees for the period concerned.
6. A refund will only be considered if a refund request is filled out and turned in two weeks prior to the start date of the cycle requested. If you are requesting a refund for a cycle, all but the \$55 yearly basic membership fee/registration fee and non-refundable deposits will be returned within 2-4 weeks (if approved).
7. I agree to have all necessary forms completed and submitted to the YMCA of Gloucester County at least two weeks in advance of each session of camp.
8. All payments must be paid in full within the date started to receive the stated rate. All late fees apply after any payment due date.
9. The YMCA of Gloucester County reserves the right to photograph or film any member and use said pictures or film for any form of advertising or promotion as deemed appropriate.
10. Financial Assistance is available for camp where funds are available. Not all camps are eligible for assistance.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS & PICK UP AUTHORIZATION

Please list all persons authorized to pick up your child. Parents or guardian names must be included on this list. You will be given pick up cards to distribute to everyone on this list, which must be presented when picking up your child. In emergency situations only, parent/guardian must give written permission for an individual, who is not on this list, to pick up the child listed on this application. No child will be released without a pick up card or emergency verbal/written permission. NO exceptions will be made to this policy. This is done for the safety of your child. Please make sure that the individuals on this list are aware that they may be called in an emergency to pick up your child. You are welcome to add or delete from this list at any time, however you will be responsible for retrieving any invalid cards. Please indicate if a non-custodial parent has limits on visitation or pick-up. If a non-custodial parent has been denied visitation or has limited visitation by court order, a copy of the order must be given to the YMCA and kept on file at the program.
